

Scholarship Program

Two medical scholarships are awarded yearly by the Health Alliance of Clinton County to deserving candidates already working in the medical field in Clinton County. The scholarships may be used to pursue a nursing career, become certified in their field of interest, or change to another course of a medically related study. It also can be put towards acquiring advanced education in their chosen medical field. These scholarships can be applied for through the HACC.
